**Part-I**

**Item No.1:** **To consider the proposal of M.M.E.R.C's Z.V.M. Unani Medical College, Pune(UNPG0001) running PG-Unani course for the academic year 2021-2022.**

"Discussed.

The Principal of the college requested one week time to submit the copies of Form No.16 of teaching and non teaching staff & furnish the details of designation of non teaching staff mentioned in the proposal.

Considering the request one week time is granted to submit the copies of Form No.16 of teaching and nonteaching staff and particulars/designation of non teaching staff. The copies of Form No.16 be submitted in the order of chronology as per the names mentioned in the online proposal. So also furnish the copies of letter of approval of teaching staff. The Compliance be made within one week".

**Item No.2:** **To consider the proposal of Rajashri Shahu College of Law, Vikhroli, Mumbai (LLB3050) running L.L.B. 3 years course for approval of fees for the academic year 2021-2022 & 2022-2023.**

Heard.

The Incharge Principal of the Institute/College submits that amount to the tune of Rs. 66,57,000/- has been refunded to those students, who are still studying in the Institution. Out of Rs. 66,57,000/- the amount to the tune of Rs. 32,00,000/- has been refunded by way of adjustment in the fees of subsequent years to be payable by such students. The amount to the tune of Rs. 34,00,000/- has been transferred by way of Bank transfer in the Bank Accounts of students by issuing the account payee cheques in the name of individual students to whom the excess fees to be refunded. The Incharge Principal of the college is directed to file an affidavit mentioning the amount refunded by way of adjustment as well as bank transfer & the

supporting documents showing the acknowledgement in the nature of receipts of payment executed by the students. The compliance to this effect be made within one week.

The Incharge Principal of the college and the Secretary of the Institution requested to provide four weeks time to file the list of the students who have left the college and the amount to be refunded to each of such students as well as the time required to refund the amount. The list of students & time required to refund the amount be submitted within four week.

**Item No.3:**

**To consider the proposal of Dhirajlal Talakchand Sankalchand Shah College of Law Mumbai Suburban (LLB324721020) for approval of fees for the academic year 2021-2022 & 2022-2023.**

Heard.

The Treasurer of the Trust submitted that inspite of giving advertisement the Institute could not secured qualified person to be appointed as the Principal of the Law College run by their Trust. Due to this reason, Dr. M.S. Kurade who has earlier worked with the Institute as the Principal of Commerce College given charge of the post of the Principal of the Law College. Dr. M.S. Kurade admitted that he is not qualified for the post of Principal of the Law College. He neither holds the requisite qualification nor the age limit prescribed for the post of Principal of the Law College. He also admit that his appointment was not approved by the University. He has attended the age of superannuation and now he is 68 years old.

The Authority is of view the appointment of Dr. M.S. Kurade as the incharge principal of the College was ab-initio void. He is not qualified even to be considered for the post of the lecturer in the Law College. Only for the reason the qualified person was not available, the Institute was not justified in appointing any person from another stream to hold the charge of post of Principal of the Law College. It was therefore decided to disallow the salary

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paid to Dr. M.S. Kurade the Incharge Principal. After disallowing the salary paid to Dr. M.S. Kurade the fees has been worked out as under;

**Item No.4:** **To consider the proposal of K. J. Somaiya College of Physiotherapy, Sion, Mumbai (MPT0001) running Bachelor of Physiotherapy and Master of Physiotherapy courses for approval of fees for the academic year 2022-2023.**

The Officials present tendered the particulars of expenditure of Rs. 92,61,808/- claimed in the proposal as other expenses. They have not disputed the additional income earned by the College.

The Chief Finance Officer submitted that the college has shown the hospital expenses of Rs. 4,94,72,210/- & income of Rs. 1,69,47,658/-. It is submitted that the hospital expenditure of Rs. 4,94,72,210/- as claimed in the proposal in fact not the hospital expenditure of the Physiotherapy college but the same has been worked as share of hospital deficit of the Medical college run by the Trust. He submitted that out of the total hospital deficit to the tune of Rs. 21 crores of Medical college, the trust has apportioned the same amongst the Medical College, Physiotherapy College and Nursing College run by the Trust. Close for finalising the fees".

**Item No.5: To consider the proposal of M.S.P Mandals Law College, Beed(LLB5040) running L.L.B. 5 years course for approval of fees for the academic year 2022-2023.**


"In spite of notice given to the Principal of the college to personally appear for the hearing, neither Principal nor any person representing the Institute appeared.

Issue fresh notice calling upon the Principal of the college to appear in person with the record of the Institute to finalize the fees of the Institution.
