In the Law Building, which spans seven floors, an organized waste management system is in place to ensure effective handling of waste materials. Dustbins are strategically placed on each floor, making it convenient for students, faculty, and staff to dispose of their waste properly.


Once the waste bins on each floor are collected, the housekeeping staff transports the waste to the ground floor of the Law Building. On the ground floor, there are designated dustbins for further segregation into dry waste and wet waste. This secondary sorting process ensures that waste is efficiently categorized for appropriate disposal or recycling.

On the ground floor, the dry waste dustbins are used to collect materials such as plastics, metals, and paper, while the wet waste dustbins are designated for organic and food-related waste. This clear distinction is essential for effective recycling and composting processes. The housekeeping staff ensures that these dustbins are emptied regularly to prevent overflow and maintain hygiene.

The segregated waste collected on the ground floor is then prepared for collection by the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC). The institution ensures timely and efficient disposal of both dry and wet waste. BMC personnel come to the college on a scheduled basis to collect the waste from the designated areas. The waste is then transported to appropriate facilities where it undergoes further processing, recycling, or disposal according to municipal regulations.

As for e-waste, the NSS Unit, Rotaract Club, Nature's Club and the Events Committee of D.T.S.S. College of Law jointly organize an awareness drive where designated e-waste collection points are set up across the campus. Outdated or malfunctioning electronic equipment such as computers, printers, charges, cables, mobile phones etc. can be deposited. This prevents improper disposal and encourages responsible recycling of electronic items.

The college promotes sustainability by educating the campus community about the importance of waste segregation and responsible disposal. Awareness campaigns and signage throughout the building encourage everyone to participate actively in maintaining a clean and eco-friendly environment. The waste management system reflects the institution's commitment to reducing its environmental footprint and fostering a culture of sustainability.
