LANGUAGE, COMMUNICATION AND ADVOCACY SKILLS

Effective language, communication, and advocacy skills are fundamental for law students, as they form the bedrock of legal practice. For example, in a consumer protection case, a lawyer must advocate for a client who has been wronged by a corporation, presenting evidence and legal arguments to support the client's claim. 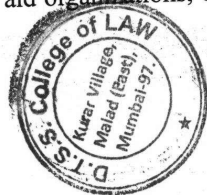
Inauguration Ceremony:

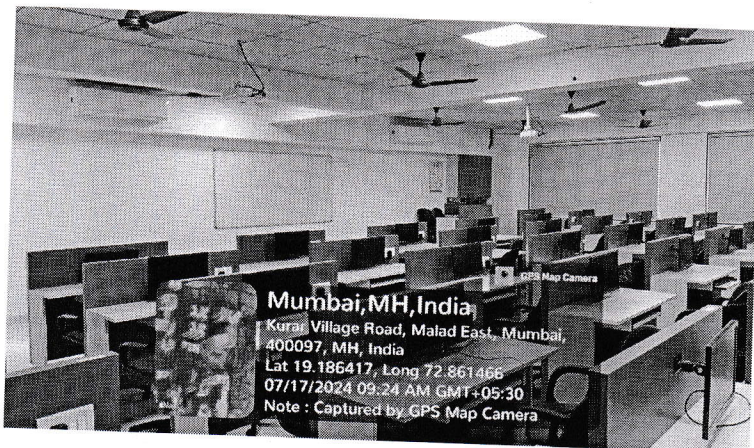
